

Drexel Crime Report

June 20, 2007

TH | PA

A non-Drexel student parked his Red Hyundai, and when he returned he found the right passenger window broken and a blue backpack, containing \$180 worth of clothing, was missing. The individual was advised to file a report with PPD.
