In resolution of the University of Georgia's judicial process only, I admit that I violated the following University Conduct Regulation(s):

CR.4.1. - Responsible

The factual circumstances underlying the regulation(s) are:

I agree with the following sanction(s):

1. Probation: 6/10/2009. Any violation of Regulation 4 while on probation will result in suspension from the University of Georgia. Any other Conduct Regulation violation may result in suspension.

2. Educational - UHC Alcohol/Drug Education: 10/1/2008. Complete the University Health Center's Alcohol Education Program (mandated program). To sign-up for the program, contact the University Health Center at 706-542-8690 by the stated deadline. Any court mandated or athletic association mandated alcohol/drug education program will also suffice.


3. Community Service: 11/1/2008. Complete 40 hours of Community Service at a location approved by the Office of Judicial Programs. The student may use the Community Service site issued by the court (if applicable) or athletic association. Verification of completion is due in the Office of Judicial Programs by 11/1/2008. Verification is to be submitted on approved Community Service Time Sheets (obtained via the Judicial Programs webpage at www.uga.edu/judicialprograms). Supervisor information and signature must be included on the time sheet.

I have read the policy regarding an Informal Disciplinary Hearing and fully understand that by accepting this option I knowingly take full responsibility for the incident, admit that I violated the above University Conduct Regulations, waive my right to a formal disciplinary hearing, and appeal, and agree with the above sanctions. I further understand that a record of this violation will be maintained by the Office of Judicial Programs.

As required by the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act, you are hereby notified that, pursuant to the ruling of the Georgia Supreme court in the case of Red & Black Publishing v. Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, student conduct records are open records, and therefore will be released, if requested, under the Georgia Open Records Act.
