INDICATE ON THIS DIAGRAM WHAT HAPPENED

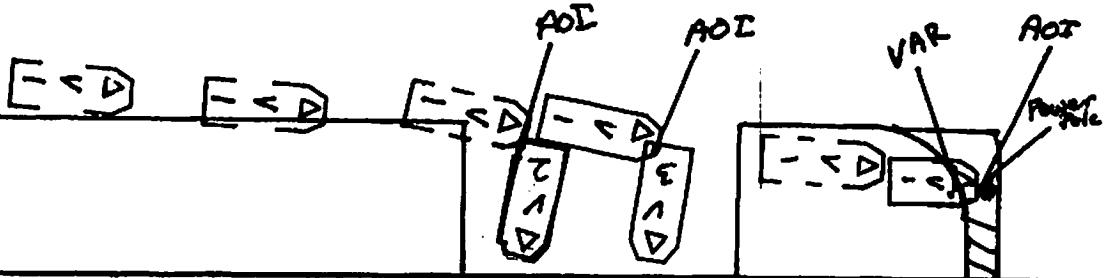

Field Sobriety Tests
The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration recognizes three Standardized Field Sobriety Tests: 1. Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus, 2. Walk and Turn, 3. One Leg Stand. Other Sobriety Tests may be used if the suspect can not perform one or more of the previously listed tests. The Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test may only be performed by officers that are certified to do so. Instructions cited below need not be verbatim.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus
Instructions:
1. I am going to check your eyes. (Please remove your glasses.)
2. (Are you wearing contacts? Hard or Soft?)
3. Keep your head still and follow this stimulus with your eyes only.
4. Do not move your head.
5. Do you understand the instructions?
Observations: Eye Color: Bro
 Suspect wearing contact lenses? Hard Soft
 Eye does not show smooth pursuit. Left Right
 Distinct Nystagmus at Max Deviation. Left Right
 Nystagmus onset prior to 45 degrees. Left Right
Notes: was unable to keep her balance.

Walk and Turn
Instructions:
1. Put your left foot on the line and then put your right foot in front of it with your right heel touching your left toe. Keep your hands at your side. (Demonstrate)
2. Do not walk until I tell you to do so.
3. Do you understand?
4. When I tell you to begin, take 9 heel-to-toe steps. (Demonstrate)
5. When you turn, keep your front foot on the line and turn taking a series of small steps with the other foot (Demonstrate)
6. Keep your arms at your sides at all times, watch your feet, and count each step out loud. Do not stop until you have completed the test.
7. Do you understand the instructions?
8. You may begin.
Notes: she started test too soon. It took her about 45 sec to start the test when I told her to go.

3. When I tell you, I want you to raise one leg six inches off the ground, foot held out, toes pointed, look at elevated foot. (Demonstrate)
4. Remain in this position for thirty seconds, counting in the following manner: 1001, 1002, 1003 and so on until I tell you to stop.
5. Do you understand the instructions?
6. You may begin.
