
I agree with the following sanction(s):

1. Reprimand: 5/9/2008: This agreement serves as a reprimand. It is expected that University Conduct Regulations be followed in the future.



He is planning on returning to UGA for graduate school and will be on probation for one year. Any violation of Regulation 7 while on probation would result in suspension from UGA for a minimum of one semester.

I have read the policy regarding an Informal Disciplinary Hearing and fully understand that by accepting this option I knowingly take full responsibility for the incident, admit that I violated the above University Conduct Regulations, waive my right to a formal disciplinary hearing, and appeal, and agree with the above sanctions.
