## Malagasy Biting Cockroach

### ATTENTION PEST CONTROL COMPLIANCE ORDER:

Pursuant to Pest Control Civil Ordinance 0708 the following

areas SAK HALL 1<sup>st</sup> Floor

have been treated to control the Malagasy Biting Cockroach.

Test traps indicate that this area may be contaminated.

The Malagasy Biting Cockroach is a non-native species with

potentially severe negative impact on our native Hawaiian

habitat. They are aggressive and are known to bite humans.

These bites, in limited cases, produce nausea and swelling.

Please report any contact with this insect to UH Pest Control Services (number below).

**Attention:** Your area has been treated with Stronten AR, an environmentally neutral, non-toxic insect bait. This bait is not harmful to humans. However, it is recommended that persons with seasonal congestion, sensitive skin or hair follicles, or known food allergies avoid this area, and avoid contact with objects in this area (papers, desk materials, machinery, books) for the 36 to 72 hours. Stronten AR is also known to react negatively with drugs used to combat drowsiness.

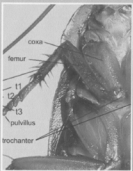
